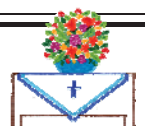

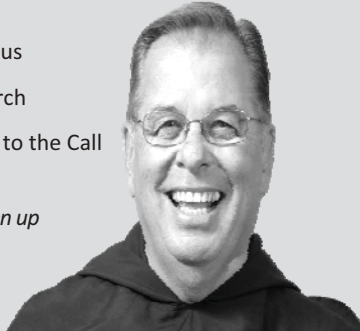

### **BREVE COMENTARIO A LA LITURGIA DE HOY** **ORANTES Y HUMILDES**

Concluimos hoy con los cuatro domingos dedicados al tema de la oración. Evaluemos nuestro camino, si hemos logrado aprender algo, pero sobre todo, si hemos intensificado nuestro hábito de orar. Meditemos cuántas oportunidades se nos presentan a nuestra comunidad hispana para orar juntos y revisemos si las aprovechamos o no; tal vez ni siquiera estamos enterados de ellas. ¿Sabía usted que aparte de la Misa dominical los hispanos tenemos otro espacio de oración comunitaria que nos puede hacer crecer como comunidad? Así es: los Martes a las 6:30 PM tenemos Misa hispana también. Esta misa es un poco más corta que la de los Domingos, porque regularmente leemos solamente una lectura, además del Evangelio, y algunas oraciones de Domingo se suprimen entre semana. Una misa de entre semana dura aproximadamente 25 minutos.

Por otra parte, debe usted saber que de entre todas las oraciones que hacemos, la oración eucarística nos reserva los mayores beneficios, porque es con el mismo Cristo Sacramentado que expresamos nuestras necesidades y alabanzas a Dios. Si la oración es buena, la oración eucarística es excelente. Los primeros Martes de cada mes tenemos unos momentos de esta oración después de la celebración de la Misa. Si usted se hace un espacio venga y experimente por usted mismo para que después pueda ser también testigo de todo lo que esta oración logra.

Deseo sinceramente que usted pueda progresar en la oración, porque verdaderamente estos tiempos son difíciles y necesitamos serenar el espíritu ante las situaciones de cada día. Hoy la liturgia nos enseña que sin humildad hacer oración es poco peor que perder el tiempo. La oración con humildad es bien recibida por Dios; es Jesús mismo quien nos lo enseña así. Entonces a trabajar, los que tienen la gracia de orar con menos frecuencia, traten de orar insistentemente; y quienes saben que oran con constancia añadan humildad a su oración. Así acrecentaremos nuestra relación con Dios en frecuencia y en calidad.

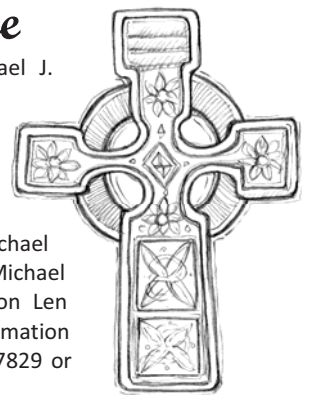

## *A Note from Bishop Dennis Sullivan – October 14<sup>th</sup>*

Dear Parishioners:

Yesterday I received a request from Archbishop Joseph E. Kurtz, President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, requesting that a special national collection be taken up to assist those affected by Hurricane Matthew in the United States and the Caribbean.

Given our connection to the Haitian Cardinal, His Eminence Chibly Cardinal Langlois, Bishop of Les Cayes, who has relatives in our diocese and who visits the Haitian Community in South Jersey frequently, I am directing that the funds collected in this special appeal be used to support the relief efforts in Southwestern Haiti which was devastated by 120 mph winds and flooding rains. As you can imagine there is immediate need for such necessities as water, food, shelter, and medical care, as well as to the long-term need to rebuild and recover after widespread destruction.

Therefore I ask that you make a special appeal to your parishioners, who are always most generous, to assist in these relief efforts. I encourage you to conduct a special collection on the weekend of **October 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup>**.

We join with our Holy Father who invited everyone "to join me in prayer for these brothers and sisters, so sorely tried. I assure my closeness to the people and express confidence in the sense of solidarity of the international community, of Catholic institutions and people of good will."
